- Bus Disposal
 - Researching existing lien
 - Recently cleaned to address eyesore
- Sanctuary Lighting/Ceiling
 - Upgrade to LED, reduce peak usage 90%
 - Ceiling tiles replaced concurrently

- Vendor Management
 - Document approved vendors for projects
 - Aid transition each year
- Grounds
 - Instead of volunteer workday decide to outsource
- Glass Replacement
 - Sanctuary and hallway

- Security
 - Traffic control officer
 - Officer also walks perimeter during services
 - Fire Drill in October
- COVID Protocol
 - Mask only area reduced in sanctuary
 - All other restrictions revoked

- Basement Flooding
 - Three water inflows two are normal maintenance
 - One channel is beyond scope of regular maintenance and requires professional engineering
 - Site visit planned to determine resolution

- Church Bell Project
 - Is there congregational support to recommission bells?
 - Prior damage to bell system exploring digital replacement system
 - Uses: call to worship, funerals, carols, etc also exploring if tornado/fire warning possible
 - One proposal: \$18,000 exploring Memorial Fund and designated contributions for this project, NOT general operating funds
 - Does the admin council affirm moving forward with this project and seeking funding?

Finance Damien Corlew

- Financial Notes
 - Revenue and Expenses Projected are based on previous 4 years data
 - Expected Revenue to be <u>less</u> than budgeted \$1.055M due to:
 - # of pledged givers being less than budgeted pledged givers
 - New lead pastor typically accounts for 3-5% decrease in member giving
 - Cash on hand is healthy: \$1.026M with \$370k unrestricted.
 - Expecting \$5k in moving expenses and \$4k in medical offset payments that were unbudgeted
 - 42% in pledge giving received in first 4 months of year

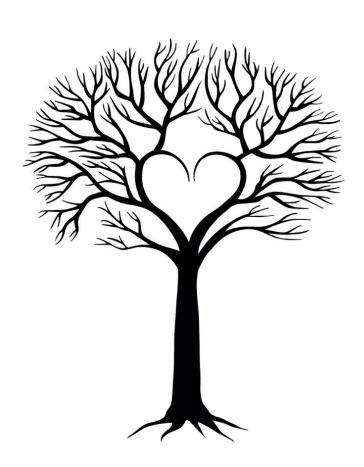

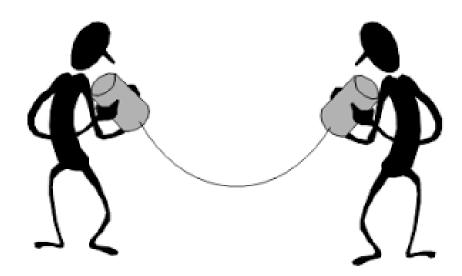
