

## SUPPORTING OUR MINISTRIES...

### Our House

Our church building and campus serve over 500 people each week in spiritual development and education and hosts 10 outside organizations as part of our Christian mission. Our house costs \$257k per year to maintain - everything from 36 AC units to toilet paper. We are debt free, allowing most of our giving to go directly to the missions of the church.

### Our People - Adults

Within our house are our people, who accept everyone without exceptions. We are about relationships with Christ, with one another, and with God's hurting world. Giving supports relationship-building missions such as church retreats, social activities, and music ministries that deepen our faith and connections with each other and our community.

### Our People - Children and Youth

Your support guides our children and youth on their journeys of faith through programming, curriculum, and opportunities to build relationships and serve.

- Education programs serving over 100 youth and children
- Sunday night children's groups serving 42 children
- Confirmation class (16 youth in 2024)
- Youth Mission Trip to Mountain Top (19 youth in 2024)
- Choir Tour (34 youth in 2024)
- Vacation Bible School (45 children in 2024)

### Our Community

Financial support of our house and our people allows us to serve those in need.

- Prison Ministry - creating 780 volunteer interactions annually and feeding 400 at Christmas
- Room in the Inn - relaunching with a plan to host and feed 215 overnight guests annually
- Other missions of Christ UMC include GraceWorks, Meals on Wheels, the Society of St. Andrew Potato Drop, One Gen Away, Miriam's Promise, Habitat for Humanity, Last Minute Toy Store, the Kindness campaign, and the Franklin Pride Festival.
